

## **Dependent Benefit**

### *Benefits to the family on the death of a member before attaining civil service retirement age*

1. A member who is not married and when no spousal and children benefits are payable on death and leaves behind dependent biological or legally adopted father or mother, then such dependent biological or legally adopted father or mother is entitled to dependent benefits, provided that at least 120 monthly contributions has been made to the Tier 1 account as per *clauses 17, 18 and 19* and the member has served a minimum of 10 years. The member may nominate either his/her dependent biological or legally adopted father or mother to claim his/her benefits on his/her death. The benefit to his/her dependent biological or legally adopted father or mother when payable shall be fifty (50) percent of the member's pension or thirty (30) percent of ACSSI, whichever is greater. Such benefits shall commence from the month following the date of the death of the member or the date when the nominated dependent parent attains minimum civil service retirement age whichever is later.
